Codes

The following codes provide information about transport, accommodation, level of difficulty and other factors which affect certain trips. Items are listed both for the full trip and for the sections to which they apply.

- A Aircraft. A light aircraft is used to transport passengers to and/or from the walk.
- **B** Boat. A boat is used to transport passengers to and/or from the walk.
- C Cruise. A price includes a boat cruise other than Yellow Waters.
- **F** Float plane. The aircraft transporting passengers will land on the water. These cost more than conventional aircraft.
- G Guide, Aboriginal. You will be accompanied by one or more Aboriginal people for a day or more. (Overseas = local guide)
- H Helicopter. Helicopter transport is provided.
- J On Jawoyn or other Aboriginal Land.
- L Limited numbers. Generally 9 including the guide. Prices reflect the smaller maximum group size.
- N Night's budget accommodation included. On trips where one section ends the day before the next section begins, accommodation between sections is included for those doing both sections.
- S Swimming. Major swims are involved. All those taking part must be able to swim at least 200 metres unaided.
- T Tucker, bush. Aboriginal bush tucker & culture walk included
- X Exploratory. A part of this trip will be to places none of our guides have been before.
- Y Yellow Waters Cruise is included in the indicated section(s).

Major Changes for 2018 - Some of the issues

WA Parks will no longer permit bushwalking between 1 March and 10 June in many of the parks where we operate.

WA Parks will not issue Mitchell Plateau Permits of any kind until they have come to a formal arrangement with the Wunambul Gaambera Aboriginal Corporation.

In Kakadu, one of our most important off-season bushwalking areas has been closed because of concerns expressed bt the traditional owners.

Many other areas we have gone in the past now require new approvals.
